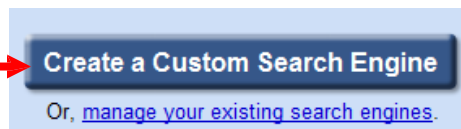


Google Custom Search Engine

1. If you don't have one already, you will need to create a Google account. Use your school email as your username to register.
2. Go to <http://www.google.com/cse/>, login if needed, and click here:



3. Next, **set up your search engine**:

- a. **Name** it based upon a particular unit/topic that students are required to research.
- b. Add a **Description** (perhaps of the kinds of sites that will be included.)
- c. Keep the **Language** as English (except AP Spanish class possibly.)
- d. Copy/paste **at least five Sites** (one per line) to be included in the results list.
- e. Leave the default , **Standard edition**.
- f. Accept the **Terms of Service** and click **Next**.

4. Customize your search engine, **test it out**, and click **Next** when you're satisfied. **DO NOT copy/paste CODE FROM THIS PAGE.** (If you want to embed your search engine, use the code from the Control Panel page. Embedding is NOT REQUIRED however.)

5. Get the URL for your custom search engine and **copy/paste on your Classwork page.**

- Click the **sites** link underneath the Next Steps section at the bottom.
- Choose **Basics** under **Control Panel** on the left side.
- Click the **homepage** link at top right.

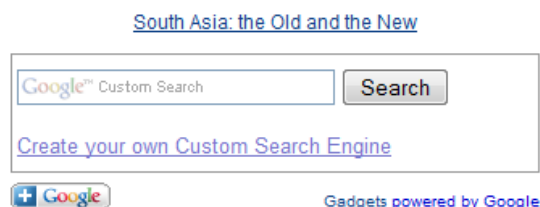
Basic information

- Click the **Add this search engine to your blog or webpage** link IF YOU WANT TO EMBED the search engine instead.

- You should see a preview of your gadget. Click the **Get the Code** button at the bottom of the page and copy the code.
- Use this code to embed the search engine in the correct place on your Classwork page. Choose **Insert > More Plugins > HTML & Gadgets > Google Gadgets**.
- Paste the code and click **Next > Insert Plugin**



You can always edit your search engine by returning to the **Google Custom Search** home page. Click **manage your existing search engine**, and then click the **control panel**.
