
## Google Custom Search Engine

1. If you don't have one already, you will need to create a Google account. Use your school email as your username to register.



- a. Name it based upon a particular unit/topic that students are required to research.
- b. Add a **Description** (perhaps of the kinds of sites that will be included.)
- c. Keep the Language as English (except AP Spanish class possibly.)
- d. Copy/paste at least five **Sites** (one per line) to be included in the results list.
- e. Leave the default, Standard edition.
- f. Accept the **Terms of Service** and click **Next**.

**4.** Customize your search engine, test it out, and click **Next** when you're satisfied. **DO NOT** copy/paste CODE FROM THIS PAGE. (If you want to embed your search engine, use the code from the Control Panel page. Embedding is NOT REQUIRED however.)

- 5. Get the URL for your custom search engine and copy/paste on your Classwork page.
  - Click the **sites** link underneath the Next Steps section at the bottom.
  - Choose Basics under Control Panel on the left side.
  - Click the homepage link at top right.

Your search engine's name and description will be shown on its Google homepage.

- You should see a preview of your gadget. Click the **Get the Code** button at the bottom of the page and copy the code.
- Use this code to embed the search engine in the correct place on your Classwork page. Choose Insert > More Plugins > HTML & Gadgets > Google Gadgets.
- Paste the code and click Next > Insert Plugin



You can always *edit* your search engine by returning to the Google Custom Search home page. Click manage your existing search engine, and then click the control panel.
